THIS MATTER having come before the Court upon the motion of Plaintiff for a Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause, and the Court having reviewed the Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order, Order to Show Cause, and Preliminary Injunction as well as the Declaration of Christopher W. Pirnke and the exhibits attached thereto, and it appearing to the Court that the Plaintiff has a clear legal right and valid claim to ensure that the initiative process is performed correctly, the Court finds that a Temporary Restraining Order is appropriate to preserve the status quo until a show cause hearing can be held and that substantial, immediate and irreparable injury, loss and damage may result to the Plaintiff absent such an order, now therefore it is hereby ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. Plaintiff's Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order is granted

3. The King County Elections Director shall not (1) count or cause to be counted any additional signatures related to the Initiative, (2) shall not certify the number of signatures related to the Initiative or certify the sufficiency of the signatures, and (3) shall not place the Initiative on the Ballot;

4. The City and the City Council shall not (1) direct the City Clerk to take any action in relation to the Initiative or (2) take any action to select pro- and con- statement committees;

7. Defendants are hereby directed to appear and show cause at 8:30 a.m. on August 1, 2019, before Judge Scott of the King County Superior Court Regional Justice Center, Room 3H at 401 4th Avenue North, Kent, Washington 98032, why a preliminary injunction should not be issued.
